INSP's Original Historical Docudrama Series *Wild West Chronicles* to Premiere its 2nd Season on Thursday, July 28th at 8PM ET

Series description:

Once a feared lawman, the legendary Bat Masterson trades his sheriff's badge for a pen to chase stories instead of outlaws. Each week, the gunslinger-turned-newspaperman travels the frontier to chronicle the wildest stories of the Old West.

Episodic descriptions; premiere dates and times:

- "The Bone War" (Thursday, July 28th at 8PM ET):
 - It's not gold that inspires a rush of treasure hunters to flood the windblown bluffs of Wyoming; it's bones. After stumbling upon a strange fossil, a man is caught in the crossfire of rival paleontologists warring over a trove of dinosaur bones.
- "The Texas Fence-Cutting War" (Thursday, July 28th at 8:30PM ET):
 - When homesteaders keep cutting down her fences to access grazing land and water, a widowed landowner teams up with famed Texas Ranger Ira Aten to protect her property. Aten hopes his explosive plan of action will force the cutters to compromise.
- "Pinkerton Detectives Track a Killer" (Thursday, August 4th at 8PM ET):
 - After a bank robbery, two Pinkerton detectives join forces to track the notorious Missouri Kid. During a shootout, the Missouri Kid kills seasoned detective Charles Schumacher, leaving young George Dougherty to finish the job and avenge his death.
- "The Legend of Nat Love" (Thursday, August 4th at 8:30PM ET):
 - When Black cowboy Nat Love overnights in Deadwood during a cattle drive, he decides to enter a Fourth of July cowboy competition. Confident in his roping, riding, and shooting skills, he is eager to test his mettle against the best cowboys around.
- "The Masterson Brothers Part 1" (Thursday, August 11th at 8PM ET):
 - After Marshal Ed Masterson is shot while breaking up a barroom brawl, he hastily bans all firearms in Dodge City. Ed's swift proclamation is met with disdain by most townsfolk, including his own brothers, and places an even larger target on his back.
- "The Masterson Brothers Part 2" (Thursday, August 11th at 8:30PM ET):

- After Marshal Ed Masterson is gunned down in Dodge City, his youngest brother, James, decides to follow in his footsteps and become a lawman. But when James' life is threatened, middle brother Bat Masterson races back from Arizona to protect his kin.
- **“Doc Susie Goes Underground” (Thursday, August 18th at 8PM ET):**
 - After the suspicious death of a tunnel worker, and unconvincing answers from the project's lead engineer, Doc Susie goes on a covert mission to find out what happened. Deep underground, she finds her own life in peril when she's trapped by a cave-in.
- **“The Gold Rush Lawman” (Thursday, August 18th at 8:30PM ET):**
 - When failed prospector John Hicks Adams is elected sheriff of Santa Clara County, he must prove that he won't be a bust as a lawman too. Just weeks into the job, his courage is tested when a band of stagecoach robbers begins terrorizing the area.
- **“Last Shot at the OK Corral” (Thursday, August 25th at 8PM ET):**
 - In an odd twist of fate, photographers C.S. and Mollie Fly decide to open a studio next to a dusty corral in Tombstone, Arizona, and they end up taking the last shot of the Old West's most infamous gun battle, the Shootout at the O.K. Corral.
- **“Jim Roberts Cleans Up Jerome” (Thursday, August 25th at 8:30PM ET):**
 - In his first week on the job as the new constable of Jerome, Arizona, Jim Roberts gets to work arresting the town's troublemakers and teaching his timid deputy how to be a courageous lawman as they track down a stone-cold killer and his gang.
- **“Battle Beneath the Mountain” (Thursday, September 1st at 8PM ET):**
 - For months, a thin wall of rock is all that keeps the peace between two rival silver mining companies 300 feet below the Idaho desert. When the barrier is finally breached, pickaxes give way to pistols and rifles, and the miners battle for five days.
